



A Planned Reopening of Saint Miriam

Post COVID-19

Summary

Preliminary Phase: Ongoing with Additions

- Campus open to visitors, walkers, etc.
- Limited staffing on Sundays remains the standard
- Livestream of both Adoration and Mass
- FM Broadcast of Sunday Mass
- Virtual Readers every Sunday via recording and video

Phase 1: Tentative Date May 17th, 2020

Church with precautionary procedures, *Wave 1*

- **Outdoor Mass - Parking Lot/Tent – 9am**
 - FM Broadcast
 - Communion hand-only; sanitized and PPE Clergy
- Livestream – Single Camera

Phase 2: Tentative Date June 8th, 2020

Infant/Daycare with precautionary procedures

1. Movement and Entry Restrictions (Floor to Floor and Admin)
2. Increased Sanitizing and Deep Cleaning Schedules CFOC Guidelines
3. *Routine* Equipment and High Traffic Sanitizing *hourly*
4. Temperature checks *routinely* during day and staff *transitions*
 - a. Documentation of all checks for staff and children **MUST** be maintained
5. *Mandatory* use of KidCheck App for check ins and pick up
6. Supplies all left in the exterior box. No inside deliveries.
7. PPE required on Staff during check in and pick up and infant care
8. Capacity Limits Monitored and Not Exceeded
9. Student Groups Limited to classroom sizes only; no mixed groups
10. Increased Outdoor Activity (Weather Permitting)
11. All applicable CDC, DOE and Internal Nurse Guidelines to be followed
12. New connecting corridor decorations – Katelyn and Meghan

Phase 3: Tentative Date June 28th, 2020

Church with precautionary procedures, *Wave 2, Post-Renovation*

Chairs, New Audio Visual, Added Camera for Livestream, Wireless/movable

- Added Mass at 12 Noon – Not Livestreamed
- Livestream – Dual Camera – 7:30am, 9:00am, 10:30am
- CDC guidelines to be followed including Temp checks/Questions
- Chair position distancing – NO changes permitted (small family & individual)
- Communion line “dot” stations

- Communion via *hand-only*
- The “Sunday obligation” to attend Mass will be dispensed
 - The elderly and those at high risk of COVID-19 will be encouraged to stay home
 - Any person exhibiting any symptoms will be advised to not attend Mass

Requirements for Mass attendees will include:

- Wearing face masks
- Proper social distancing by chairs
- Limits on the overall number of attendees per Mass (total chair count)
- No *Communal* Chalice
- No SOP

Additional Information:

- Small Groups, save Virtual, on break until fall
- Outside renters and groups, may return with precautions followed
- Weddings, Funerals, etc. may return with limited guest counts of 50<
- No additional outside renters of facilities until fall

Phase 4: Tentative Date July 6th, 2020

Summer Camp with precautionary procedures

1. Movement and Entry Restrictions (Floor to Floor and Admin)
2. Increased Sanitizing and Deep Cleaning Schedules
3. *Routine* Equipment and High Traffic Sanitizing
4. Temperature checks *at start of day* and staff *transitions*
5. *Mandatory* use of KidCheck App for check ins
6. Supplies all left in exterior box. No inside deliveries.
7. Capacity Limits Monitored and Not Exceeded
8. Increased Outdoor Activity (Weather Permitting)
9. Gardening activities to be introduced to facilitate outdoor life
10. All applicable CDC, DOE and Internal Nurse Guidelines to be followed

Phase 5: Fall 2020

School, Daycare, K with any remaining precautionary procedures

Normal Operations, Fall 2020 for School - ***Tentative Date September 9th 2020***

Parish, Groups, Activities with any remaining precautionary procedures

Normal Operations, Fall 2020 for Parish & Campus- ***Tentative Date September 20th 2020***

- Reevaluate 12 Noon Mass
- Reevaluate CDC Guidelines in place
